



## 2021 SENATE BILL 801

December 17, 2021 - Introduced by Senators AGARD, BEWLEY, SMITH, LARSON and L. TAYLOR, cosponsored by Representatives HESSELBEIN, SNODGRASS, MILROY, RIEMER, SINICKI, HEBL, CONLEY, HONG, DOYLE, VRUWINK, POPE, ANDRACA, ANDERSON, STUBBS, BOWEN, SUBECK, SHANKLAND, SHELTON, B. 1     **AN ACT** *to create* 27.01 (7) (c) 13. of the statutes; **relating to:** free state park  
2             admission for gold star families.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, no person may operate a vehicle in any state park or in certain other recreational areas on state land unless the vehicle displays a vehicle admission receipt.

This bill provides that a vehicle admission receipt is not required for any vehicle occupied by a person who qualifies under federal law for a gold star lapel button (commonly known as gold star family), which signifies that the recipient is the immediate family member of a member of the U.S. armed forces who died while serving during a time of conflict.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3             **SECTION 1.** 27.01 (7) (c) 13. of the statutes is created to read:
