2023 ASSEMBLY BILL 1027

January 29, 2024 - Introduced by Representatives BINSFELD, DRAKE, CONLEY, DONOVAN, JOERS, KRUG, MELOTIK, MURSAU, NEDWESKI, O'CONNOR, PALMERI, SCHMIDT, SINICKI, SNYDER, STUBBS and SUBECK. Referred to Committee on Education.

1 AN ACT to create 20.255 (2) (dw) of the statutes; relating to: funding a truancy

reduction grant program and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill appropriates \$2,000,000 to the Department of Public Instruction for truancy reduction grants in the 2024–25 school year. The bill specifies that if LRB-5489 is not enacted into law during the 2023 legislative session, the appropriation created in this bill is void. LRB-5489 requires DPI to establish and implement a grant program under which DPI must awards grants to eligible school districts for the purpose of reducing truancy.
