## 2023 ASSEMBLY BILL 1154

- March 6, 2024 Introduced by Representatives SHANKLAND, STUBBS, EMERSON, ANDRACA, BALDEH, CONLEY, JACOBSON, JOERS, MOORE OMOKUNDE, NEUBAUER, OHNSTAD, ORTIZ-VELEZ, RATCLIFF, SINICKI, SNODGRASS, SUBECK and PALMERI, cosponsored by Senators SMITH, L. JOHNSON, CARPENTER, LARSON, ROYS, SPREITZER and AGARD. Referred to Committee on State Affairs.
- 1 AN ACT relating to: grants for crisis intervention teams and making an 2 appropriation.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides \$1,000,000 for the Department of Health Services to award grants to counties, cities, towns, villages, and American Indian tribes or bands in this state in the 2023–25 fiscal biennium for the staffing of law enforcement agencies with mental health crisis intervention teams. Under current law, DHS must award grants totaling \$1,000,000 in each fiscal biennium for mental health crisis intervention team training for law enforcement agencies and correctional officers.
