Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill authorizes a county to appropriate money to a nonprofit organization that operates a food bank or food pantry in the county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 59.53 (3) of the statutes is renumbered 59.53 (3) (intro.) and

victims of domestic violence and related crimes. The county may also appropriate
money for making payments to such a nonprofit organization for its capital and
operational expenses.

SECTION 2. 59.53 (3) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

5 59.53 (3) (c) Making payments to a nonprofit organization, as defined in s. 6 23.197 (4) (a) 1., whose primary purpose is to operate a food bank or food pantry and 7 who serves the county as part of that operation.
