- AN ACT to create 84.10313 of the statutes; relating to: designating and marking
- the Ho-Chunk World War II Code Talkers Memorial Highway.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs the Department of Transportation to designate and mark I 90 from the Minnesota-Wisconsin state line in La Crosse County to the intersection of I 90 and I 94 in Monroe County as the "Ho-Chunk World War II Code Talkers Memorial Highway."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 84.10313 of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 84.10313 Ho-Chunk World War II Code Talkers Memorial Highway. The
 5 department shall designate and mark I 90 from the Minnesota-Wisconsin state line
 6 in La Crosse County to the intersection of I 90 and I 94 in Monroe County as the
- 7 Ho-Chunk World War II Code Talkers Memorial Highway, in honor of Bill
