Anderson, Clancy, Emerson, Gustafson, Jacobson, Joers, Madison, Palmeri, Ratcliff, Schmidt, Shankland and Sinicki, cosponsored by Senators Cabral-Guevara, Roys and Spreitzer. Referred to Committee on Government Accountability and Oversight.

- 1 AN ACT to amend 1.10 (4); and to create 1.10 (3) (w) of the statutes; relating
- 2 to: designating the bacterium Lactococcus lactis as the Wisconsin state

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law designates a variety of state symbols and requires the *Wisconsin Blue Book* to include information about them. This bill designates the bacterium Lactococcus lactis as the Wisconsin state microbe and requires the *Wisconsin Blue Book* to include that information.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 4 **Section 1.** 1.10 (3) (w) of the statutes is created to read:
- 5 1.10 (3) (w) The bacterium Lactococcus lactis is the state microbe.
- **Section 2.** 1.10 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 7 1.10 (4) The Wisconsin Blue Book shall include the information contained in
