Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Revenue, in each year from 2024 through 2027, to provide grants of up to \$5,000 to political subdivisions with populations of less than 10,000 to be used to obtain grant writing and compliance assistance services. These grants may be used to obtain services only for grants related to public works, transportation infrastructure, or public safety.

(d) A grant under this subsection may not exceed \$5,000.

the joint committee on finance evaluating the program under this subsection.
