Whereas, the United States government has confirmed 30 Americans killed, 13 4 5 unaccounted for, and numerous others held hostage as a result of Hamas's barbaric 6 attack against Israel on October 7, 2023; and 7 Whereas, a terrorist attack against Americans of this magnitude has not 8 occurred since September 11, 2001; and 9 Whereas, while the citizens of Wisconsin acknowledge the horrific attacks 10 against Jewish people and the State of Israel, we also recognize that this atrocity 11 targets the American people; and 12 Whereas, the Wisconsin State Legislature, as a collective body, condemns all 13 forms of anti-Semitic rhetoric on Wisconsin's college or university campuses; now,
