Johnson, Kitchens, Magnafici, Michalski, Moses, Murphy, Mursau, Novak, O'Connor, Penterman, Rettinger, Shankland, Sinicki and Edming, cosponsored by Senators Feyen, Cowles, Jacque and Taylor. 1	Relating to: proclaiming November 13 to 19, 2023 as Wisconsin Apprenticeship
<b>2</b>	Week.
3	Whereas, each November the nation and Wisconsin celebrate Apprenticeship
4	Week to raise awareness of this career pathway for individuals to start a career in
5	this state; and
6	Whereas, Wisconsin has a rich tradition of promoting apprenticeship training
7	as the first state to create a registered apprenticeship law, which is seen as a national
8	model for other states, and as one of the first in the nation to create a youth
9	apprenticeship program to help students gain experience while still in school; and
10	Whereas, Wisconsin continues to set records for the number of registered
11	apprentices, which hit a record high in 2022 with nearly 16,000, and the same is true
12	for the youth apprenticeship program with over 8,300 students participating with
13	5,700 employers; and
14	Whereas, apprenticeship in Wisconsin has expanded to nearly all industries,
15	including agriculture, finance, transportation, health care, and construction and is

1	used by all employers to provide training to employees so they can have a long-term
2	career in our state while also earning a nationally recognized credential; and

Whereas, the apprenticeship model continues to help Wisconsin address the workforce shortage by helping employers train and hire the workers they need to keep Wisconsin's economic engine moving forward; now, therefore, be it

State Legislature hereby recognizes the week of November 13 to 19, 2023, as
Wisconsin Apprenticeship Week.
