2023 SENATE BILL 1103

April 11, 2024 - Introduced by Senators SPREITZER, CARPENTER, HESSELBEIN, L. JOHNSON, LARSON, SMITH and WIRCH, cosponsored by Representatives VINING, MOORE OMOKUNDE, PALMERI, CONSIDINE, NEUBAUER, SNODGRASS, CABRERA, RATCLIFF, CLANCY, J. ANDERSON, ANDRACA, BARE, CONLEY, DRAKE, EMERSON, JOERS, SINICKI and SUBECK. Referred to Committee on Education.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 20.255 (2) (fi) and 115.403 of the statutes; **relating to:** grants
2 for LGBTQIA+ rights training for school counselors and school social workers
3 and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under this bill, the Department of Public Instruction must award grants to school boards to provide training in LGBTQIA+ rights, in a program developed or approved by DPI, to school counselors and school social workers employed by school boards. The bill defines “LGBTQIA+” as lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, intersex, or any other nonheterosexual or noncisgender orientation, identity, or expression.

9 **SECTION 3.** 115.403 of the statutes is created to read:

10 **115.403 LGBTQIA+ rights training grants.** (1) In this section,
11 “LGBTQIA+” means lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, intersex, or any other
12 nonheterosexual or noncisgender orientation, identity, or expression.

13 (2) The department shall award grants to school boards to provide training on
14 the rights of LGBTQIA+ individuals, in a program developed or approved by the
15 department, to school counselors and school social workers employed by a school
16 board.
