2023 SENATE BILL 679

Johnson, Larson, Spreitzer, Smith, Roys, Carpenter and Taylor, cosponsored by Representatives Hong, Conley, Sinicki, Emerson, Bare, Joers, Ratcliff, Considine, Palmeri, Jacobson, Subeck, J. - 1 AN ACT *to amend* 941.29 (1g) (a), 941.291 (1) (b) and 973.123 (1); and *to create* 2 941.285 of the statutes; **relating to:** prohibiting firearm accessories that 3 accelerate the rate of fire of a semiautomatic firearm and providing a penalty.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits the sale, manufacture, transfer, use, and possession of any device that is added after manufacture that is designed or functions to accelerate the rate of fire of a semiautomatic firearm. A person who violates the prohibition is guilty of a Class G felony.

Because this bill creates a new crime or revises a penalty for an existing crime, the Joint Review Committee on Criminal Penalties may be requested to prepare a report.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
