



2025 ASSEMBLY BILL 243

May 2, 2025 - Introduced by Representatives CALLAHAN and KNODL, cosponsored by Senator JACQUE. Referred to Committee on Tourism.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 101.05 (7) of the statutes; **relating to:** regulation of
2 amusement rides located at campgrounds.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill exempts amusement rides located at campgrounds licensed by the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection from regulation by the Department of Safety and Professional Services if they are installed according to the manufacturer's recommended standards. Under current law, DSPS regulates amusement rides.
