## 2025 ASSEMBLY BILL 307

June 6, 2025 - Introduced by Representatives PHELPS, ANDRACA, ANDERSON, ARNEY, BROWN, CLANCY, CRUZ, DESANTO, DESMIDT, EMERSON, FITZGERALD, HONG, HYSELL, JOERS, JOHNSON, KIRSCH, MADISON, MCCARVILLE, MCGUIRE, MIRESE, MOORE OMOKUNDE, NEUBAUER, PALMERI, RIVERA-WAGNER, ROE, SHEEHAN, SNODGRASS, SPAUDE, STROUD, SUBECK, TENORIO and VINING, cosponsored by Senators ROYS, LARSON, DASSLER-ALFHEIM, KEYESKI, PFAFF, RATCLIFF, SMITH, SPREITZER and WIRCH. ***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

Current law limits the percentage of pupils in each school district who may attend a private school under the statewide parental choice program. The pupil participation limit started in the 2015-16 school year at 1 percent of a school district's membership and increased gradually to 10 percent of a school district's membership in the 2025-26 school year. Under current law, the pupil participation limit sunsets after the 2025-26 school year. This bill repeals the sunset and continues the pupil participation limit at 10 percent of a school district's membership.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

4           **SECTION 1.** 118.60 (2) (be) 1. a. of the statutes is repealed.

5           **SECTION 2.** 118.60 (2) (be) 1. c. of the statutes is amended to read:

## SECTION 2

118.60 (2) (be) 1. c. “Pupil participation limit” means a school district’s membership in the previous school year multiplied by the applicable percentage for the current school year 0.1.

**SECTION 3.** 118.60 (2) (be) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

118.60 (2) (be) 2. Except as provided in subd. 2m., ~~beginning with the 2015-16 school year and ending with the 2025-26 school year,~~ the total number of pupils residing in a school district, other than an eligible school district or a 1st class city school district, who may attend a private school under this section during a school year may not exceed the school district's pupil participation limit for that school year.

**SECTION 4.** 118.60 (2) (be) 3. of the statutes is repealed.
