2025 ASSEMBLY BILL 410

August 29, 2025 - Introduced by Representatives GUNDRUM, ARMSTRONG, BARE, BEHNKE, DESMIDT, DONOVAN, GOEBEN, GOODWIN, JOHNSON, KREIBICH, ORTIZ-VELEZ, RODRIGUEZ, SINICKI, STUBBS and PALMERI, cosponsored by Senators JACQUE, DASSLER-ALFHEIM, FEYEN, RATCLIFF, SPREITZER, WIRCH, HABUSH SINYKIN, KEYESKI and LARSON. Referred to Committee on Health, Aging and Long-Term Care.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** grants for falls prevention awareness and initiatives and
2 making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs the Department of Health Services to award a grant in the amount of \$450,000 in both fiscal years 2025-26 and 2026-27 to the Wisconsin Institute for Healthy Aging for the purpose of statewide falls prevention awareness and initiatives and appropriates \$450,000 in both fiscal years 2025-26 and 2026-27 for that purpose.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.**

4 (1) GRANTS FOR STATEWIDE FALLS PREVENTION AWARENESS AND INITIATIVES.

5 From the appropriation under s. 20.435 (1) (a), the department of health services

6 shall award a grant of \$450,000 in each of fiscal years 2025-26 and 2026-27 to the

9 services under s. 20.435 (1) (a), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2026-27 is
10 increased by \$450,000 to award a grant under SECTION 1 (1) of this act.
