

2	Whereas, since 1937, the observation of Dairy Month in June has given
3	Wisconsinites an opportunity to recognize the special role dairy has played in the
4	state's agricultural heritage; and
5	Whereas, as early as the 1840s, dairy farmers from New York, then the
6	nation's leading dairy producer, migrated to Wisconsin and established a foothold
7	for the dairy industry; and
8	Whereas, in 1872, the Wisconsin Dairyman's Association was founded with

1	Whereas, by the onset of World War I, Wisconsin surpassed all other states in
2	dairy production; and
3	Whereas, starting in 1940, Wisconsin cemented its reputation as "America's
4	Dairyland" by placing this slogan on license plates; and
5	Whereas, today, over 1.28 million cows across nearly 6,000 dairy farms call
6	Wisconsin home; and
7	Whereas, the dairy industry contributes about \$45.6 billion to the state
8	economy annually; and
9	Whereas, as a key part of this industry, Wisconsin cheesemakers produce over
10	600 kinds of cheese and together produce over a quarter of the nation's cheese; and
11	Whereas, because it has touched so many Wisconsinites' lives, past and
12	present, the dairy industry is a central component of Wisconsin heritage and
13	identity; and
14	Whereas, in the month of June, the people of Wisconsin acknowledge the
15	contributions of the state's hardworking dairy farmers, who have made dairy a
16	pillar of the state's success; and
17	Whereas, these dairy farmers' unwavering dedication to the highest standards
18	of quality have consistently moved Wisconsin forward; now, therefore, be it
19	Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the legislature
20	hereby proclaims June as Dairy Month in Wisconsin.
