## **2025 SENATE BILL 136**

March 14, 2025 - Introduced by Senators Tomczyk, NASS and Spreitzer, cosponsored by Representatives Tusler, Dittrich, Gundrum, Goeben, KNODL, MELOTIK, ORTIZ-VELEZ, SINICKI and SUBECK. Referred to Committee on Transportation and Local Government.

- AN ACT to amend 347.26 (4) (a); to create 347.26 (4) (am) of the statutes; 1
- 2 relating to: school bus back-up lamps.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides that a school bus may be equipped with one back-up lamp mounted to each side of the vehicle and directed to project a white or amber light illuminating the rear wheels of the vehicle when backing. Under current law, a motor vehicle may not be equipped with more than two back-up lamps, which must be directed to project white or amber light illuminating the roadway to the rear of the vehicle for a distance of up 75 feet.

### The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 347.26 (4) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 347.26 (4) (a) Any Except as provided in par. (am), any motor vehicle may be equipped with not more than 2 back-up lamps which shall be so directed as to
- 6 project a white or amber light illuminating the roadway to the rear of such vehicle
- 7 for a distance not to exceed 75 feet.
