## 2025 SENATE BILL 308

June 2, 2025 - Introduced by Senators JAMES and QUINN, cosponsored by Representatives MOSES, ARMSTRONG, DITTRICH, MURPHY and ZIMMERMAN. Referred to Committee on Mental Health, Substance Abuse Prevention, Children and Families.

1     **AN ACT relating to:** a grant to assist in the purchase and renovation of an  
2             existing facility in the city of Chippewa Falls to provide a 50-bed treatment  
3             center to men with substance use disorders.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill requires the Department of Administration to award a grant in the amount of \$1,000,000 to Lutheran Social Services of Wisconsin and Upper Michigan, Inc., to assist in the purchase and renovation of the Libertas Treatment Center in the city of Chippewa Falls to provide a 50-bed treatment center to men with substance use disorders who are in need of recovery services.

# SENATE BILL 308

## SECTION 9101

(a) In the 2025-26 fiscal year, the department of administration shall award a grant in the amount of \$1,000,000 to Lutheran Social Services of Wisconsin and Upper Michigan, Inc., to assist in the purchase and renovation of the Libertas Treatment Center in the city of Chippewa Falls to provide a 50-bed treatment center to men with substance use disorders who are in need of recovery services.

(b) The legislature finds and determines that the grant under par. (a) serves a public purpose by addressing the need for recovery services of men in this state who suffer from substance use disorders.
