1 **Relating to:** proclaiming the week of April 28 to May 2, 2025, as School Nutrition
2 Professionals Appreciation Week.

3 Whereas, school nutrition professionals are highly skilled professionals with a
4 wide array of duties that support students in all aspects of education, including
5 preparing and serving food, complying with federal regulations, and managing the
6 dietary restrictions of students; and

7 Whereas, school meals are an integral part of a school day, and school
8 nutrition professionals care deeply about the foods that students eat, work to
9 procure locally sourced foods when possible, and spend significant time preparing
10 menus to make sure that students have the nutritious foods they need to learn and
11 grow; and

12 Whereas, school nutrition professionals care deeply about and are committed
13 to the health and well-being of students across Wisconsin, forming special

1 relationships with students and showing them their care through the meals they
2 serve; and

3 Whereas, school nutrition professionals teach kids how to select a complete
4 meal, encourage them to take fruits and vegetables, and teach kids healthy eating
5 habits that last a lifetime; and

6 Whereas, the service and environment that school nutrition professionals
7 provide to students is the closest part of the school day students have to their home
8 life and can be the most comforting aspect of the school day that students have; and

9 Whereas, school nutrition professionals work in a fast-paced, labor-intensive
10 environment that is physically and emotionally taxing, and their commitment and
11 dedication to the well-being of Wisconsin's students often go underappreciated;
12 now, therefore, be it

13 ***Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That*** the members of
14 the Wisconsin Legislature recognize April 28 to May 2, 2025, as School Nutrition
15 Professionals Appreciation Week; and, be it further

16 ***Resolved, That*** the legislature calls upon the people of Wisconsin to express
17 their honor, affirmation, love, respect, and gratitude to school nutrition
18 professionals everywhere; and, be it further

19 ***Resolved, That*** the senate chief clerk shall transmit copies of this resolution
20 to the governor of Wisconsin.
