



## 2025 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 63

1     **Relating to:** proclaiming June as Dairy Month in Wisconsin.

2           Whereas, since 1937, the observation of Dairy Month in June has given  
3     Wisconsinites an opportunity to recognize the special role dairy has played in the  
4     state's agricultural heritage; and

5           Whereas, as early as the 1840s, dairy farmers from New York, then the  
6     nation's leading dairy producer, migrated to Wisconsin and established a foothold  
7     for the dairy industry; and

8           Whereas, in 1872, the Wisconsin Dairyman's Association was founded with  
9     the goal of improving methods of making, selling, and marketing dairy products  
10    such as cheese and butter; and

11          Whereas, at the turn of the century, Wisconsin's own Stephen Babcock  
12    developed a means to test the butterfat content of milk, which revolutionized the  
13    dairy industry by enabling standards of quality that could be used to establish milk  
14    prices; and
