Prepared Testimony by Rep. David Steffen before the
Assembly Committee on Transportation
Assembly Bill 381: Law Enforcement Memorial License Plates
August 29, 2017

Chairman Ripp and Committee Members,

Thank you for holding a public hearing on Assembly Bill 381 relating to: voluntary payments associated with special distinguishing registration plates expressing support for the family members of law enforcement officers who have died in the line of duty. This simple, bipartisan bill attaches a funding option to the Law Enforcement Memorial Fund license plate, thereby allowing this specialty plate to raise funds, similar to many other specialty plates in Wisconsin, to be used towards furthering the Memorial's efforts.

The Wisconsin Law Enforcement Memorial Fund and the National Law Enforcement Memorial Fund are both non-profit organizations that provide financial support to the families of fallen law enforcement officers immediately following a line-of-duty death. Beyond these efforts, the organizations have built and maintain stone memorials on Wisconsin's capitol square and in Washington D.C. as a permanent tribute to our fallen heroes. The Law Enforcement Memorial Fund serves one of the most deserving groups of individuals, the families of fallen officers. Yet the specialty plate that recognizes the memorial, currently does nothing to assist it.

AB 381 attaches a modest \$10 donation per license plate, which will be shared equally between the Wisconsin and National Law Enforcement Memorial Funds. It is very likely that individuals who have purchased this specialty plate thought they were already supporting these organizations. AB 381 ensures that the specialty Law Enforcement Memorial Fund license plates provide financial support to these organizations, and in turn, to the families of fallen officers.

AB 381 does not create a new specialty plate, rather it allows the Law Enforcement Memorial plate to join the many other specialty plates (Donate Life Wisconsin, Inc., Celebrate Children Foundation, Wisconsin Trout Unlimited, UW System Scholarship programs, etc.), that currently raise financial support for their organizations.

This bipartisan bill is supported by the Wisconsin and National Law Enforcement Memorial Funds, as well as the Badger State Sheriffs' Association, and Wisconsin Sheriffs and Deputy Sheriffs Association. I encourage the Committee to join in supporting the honorable efforts of this memorial.

Thank you for allowing me to testify in favor of AB 381. Please support this important legislation.

Chairman Ripp and members of the Assembly Committee on Transportation, thank you for holding a public hearing on Assembly Bill 381, which would require a voluntary donation on Law Enforcement Memorial license places to raise funds for the families of fallen law enforcement officers. Acknowledging the commitment to the state exhibited by members of law enforcement and their families, I hope this committee will join me in supporting this proposal.

This proposal would raise funds for the families of fallen law enforcement officers through grants to Wisconsin Law Enforcement Memorial Fund and the National Law Enforcement Memorial for families in our state through a donation of \$10 on each Law Enforcement Memorial license plate. This bill mirrors existing special license plate laws for other charities, benevolent organizations, and efforts including Ducks Unlimited, the Lions Foundation, and the Green Bay Packers. Existing groups are able to raise over a total of \$1.5 million per year through their license plate donations.

This proposal is supported by several law enforcement agencies, including registered support from the Badger State Sheriffs' Association, Wisconsin Chiefs of Police Association, and Wisconsin Sheriffs and Deputy Sheriffs Association.

Thank you for your time today and I would appreciate your support when Assembly Bill 381 comes for a vote before this committee.
