The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

JOINT LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL PREFATORY NOTE: This draft was prepared for the joint legislative council's special committee on adoption and termination of parental rights law.

Under this draft, an attorney who represents a person in a TPR proceeding continues representation of that person during the appeal process by filing a notice of intent to appeal under s. 809.107 (2), unless the attorney has been previously discharged during the proceeding by the person or by the trial court.

- 4 48.43 (6) Judgments under this subchapter terminating parental rights are final and are
- 5 appealable under s. 808.03 (1) according to the procedure specified in s. 809.107. <u>The attorney</u>
- 6 representing a person during a proceeding under this subchapter shall continue representation
- 7 of that person by filing a notice of intent to appeal under s. 809.107 (2), unless the attorney
- 8 <u>has been previously discharged during the proceeding by the person or by the trial court.</u>
