

FARM-RAISED DEER MOVEMENT REQUIREMENTS

Any farm-raised deer that die for any reason (disease, culling, shooting preserves, slaughter, etc.) that are over 16 months of age must be tested for Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD).

CWD HERD MONITORING PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Application required with standard farm information name, address, etc.
- Inventory of all farm-raised deer on the premises including: species, age, sex, official identification of all deer over 12 months of age
- Statement from herd veterinarian that a valid veterinary/patient/client relationship exists
- Statement from herd veterinarian that there has been no clinical signs of CWD in the herd in the past 12 months
- Annual herd census filed with the department with same information as initial inventory
- Maintain herd records and include the following information on annual census all births, deaths, causes of death, CWD results if over 16 months, sales, purchases, slaughter, official identification if over 12 months

INTRASTATE REQUIREMENTS

- Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) required
- Animals must be officially identified
- Must be Tuberculosis negative
 - Accredited herd, or
 - Qualified herd within 365 days of herd anniversary date, or
 - Two negative TB tests 90-270 days apart and within 90 days of movement and animal must be isolated for all other Cervidae during the testing period
- Requires veterinarian to state on the CVI that "no farm-raised deer in the herd has shown clinical signs of chronic wasting disease in the last 12 months"
- If moved after January 1, 2004 herd must have been enrolled in CWD monitoring program under ATCP 10.66 for at least one year
 - CWD monitoring enrollment time increases one year each year until 2008 at which time any farm-raised deer moved in Wisconsin must originate from a herd enrolled in CWD monitoring program for at least 5 years
- Exemptions
 - Farm-raised deer moved directly to slaughter under a VS Form 1-27 or equivalent movement permit
 - Farm-raised deer moved between two facilities that are accredited by the American Association of Zoological Parks and Aquariums
 - Farm-raised deer move between two premises under the same registration certificate

INTERSTATE REQUIREMENTS

- Same requirements as Intrastate movement and
- Permit issued by the department prior to import
- Negative Brucellosis test within 30 days or originate from Brucellosis Certified Free herd
- Enrolled in a state sponsored CWD monitoring program for at least the past 5 years or
 - Enrollment in a state sponsored CWD monitoring program equivalent to the Wisconsin program under ATCP 10.66 with the same time enrollment requirements as intrastate requirements and
 - Statement by the issuing veterinarian that no animals have been added to the herd from outside sources for at least the past 12 months
 - No clinical signs of CWD in the herd for at least the past 5 years, herd must have records of all sales, purchases, deaths and causes of death for at least the past 5 years
