- 1. Created website on DPI main page with links to federal and state resources.
- 2. Distributed informational material to libraries and day cares (links to resources, checklists).
- 3. Superintendent Burmaster sent letter to school leaders to encourage them to develop a plan (working with their local health department).
- 4. Joined the state agency communication group to develop consistent and key messages.
- 5. Participated in the state interagency group. Group has developed a state website to which all state agencies will link their information (for consistent, up to date information).
- 6. At DPI:
