## Privacy Act Statement

Pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552a(e)(3), enacted into law by section 3 of the Privacy Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-579), the following statement is furnished to individuals who supply information to the Department of Energy (DOE) on this form. This information is maintained in a system of records designated as DOE-51, "Employee and Visitor Access Control Records."

1. AUTHORITY: 42 U.S.C. 7101, *et seq.* and 50 U.S.C. 2401 *et seq.*
2. PRINCIPAL PURPOSE(S), The records are maintained and used by the Department to track and control individuals accessing Departmental facilities and classified information areas.
3. ROUTINE USES, A record from the system may be disclosed as routine use to the appropriate local, state, or Federal agency when the record alone or in conjunction with other information, indicates a violation or potential violation of law whether civil, criminal, or regulatory; a records from this system of records may be disclosed to a member of Congress submitting a request involving the constituent when the constituent has requested assistance from the member with respect to the subject matter of the record.
