Dear Garey and Scott,

I recently received a letter from Sheriff Walter Krenzke and members of the Price County Law Enforcement Committee with regard to sexual offenders and notification of law enforcement issues. As a result, I respectfully request you consider the following in your study committee:

- Residency reporting law: Require DOC to notify local communities (via County Sheriff) that a convicted sex offender is moving to the area before it occurs.
- Require DOC to notify local government when a convicted sex offender has completed required supervision via probation and parole.

Sheriff Krenzke and/or the members of the committee would be available to testify before your committee if you wish.
