AN ACT to amend 301.45 (1d) (b) of the statutes; relating to: sex offender registration.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**JOINT LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL PREFATORY NOTE:** This bill draft was prepared for the Joint Legislative Council's Special Committee on Review of Crimes Against Children.

Current law requires sex offender registration following a conviction for a sex offense, as that term is defined in s. 301.45 (1d) (b), stats. "Sex offense" is defined to include all of the types of child enticement offenses under s. 948.07, stats.

Under s. 948.07 (5) and (6), stats., it is a Class D felony for a person to cause or attempt to cause any child under 18 years old to go into any vehicle, building, room, or secluded place, with intent to cause bodily or mental harm to a child or to give or sell a controlled substance or controlled substance analog to a child.

This draft removes these offenses from the list of offenses requiring mandatory sex offender registration.

- **SECTION 1.** 301.45 (1d) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 301.45 (1d) (b) "Sex offense" means a violation, or the solicitation, conspiracy, or
- 5 attempt to commit a violation, of s. 940.22 (2), 940.225 (1), (2) or (3), 944.06, 948.02 (1) or
- 6 (2), 948.025, 948.05, 948.055, 948.06, 948.07 (1) to (4), 948.075, 948.08, 948.085, 948.095,
- 7 948.11 (2) (a) or (am), 948.12, 948.13, or 948.30, or of s. 940.30 or 940.31 if the victim was
- 8 a minor and the person who committed the violation was not the victim's parent.

**NOTE:** This Section modifies the list of offenses for which sex offender registration is required to remove s. 948.07 (5) and (6), stats. (child enticement with intent to cause bodily or mental harm to a child or to give or sell a controlled substance or controlled substance analog to a child).
