

There are 217 schools within MPS:

- 123 Elementary schools (*including 46 K-8s*)
- 26 Middle schools
- 54 High schools
- 11 *Combined* Middle and High schools
- 3 Schools featuring Elementary to High school grades

Schools are a mix of traditional, charter, and alternative/partnership schools. In addition, the district has Early Childhood programs and Head Start.
