- Provides registration funds for the maintenance, rehabilitation and development of snowmobile trails on state property

- Provides proportional amount from education safety fees (boat, snowmobile, ATV, hunter safety in 05-07) for Department's snowmobile safety programs
- Formerly provided general purpose revenue (GPR) for trail grants portion of the program
- Registration funds designated for use for the trail grants portion of the program
- Formula transfer of state gasoline excise tax funds for the trail grants portion of the program, including supplemental maintenance payments

All safety program activities draw from this appropriation, i.e. the amount listed represents expenditure authority for all safety programs. As an example, the Department had available \$97,000 in 03-04 and expended \$81,995 for snowmobile safety program activities.
