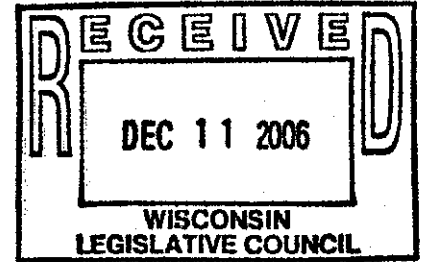

RE: Wisconsin Retirement System Coverage of Tribal Police Officers

Dear Chairman Musser:

Pursuant to your November 21, 2006 memo, the Tribal Council of Stockbridge-Munsee Community considered the concept of possible legislation of including Tribal law enforcement officers into the Wisconsin Retirement system. On December 5, 2006, the Tribal Council unanimously voted to support the concept, and instructed me notify you of the Council decision.

The Tribe recognizes that there is much work ahead and more details will need to be worked out on this issue. The Tribe also recognizes that the State and Tribe share the goal of maintaining effective law enforcement in Tribal communities, and this conceptual legislation should help achieve this goal.
