1 AN ACT relating to: a report on health education.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

JOINT LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL PREFATORY NOTE: This bill was prepared for the Joint Legislative Council's Special Committee on Health Care Access.

The draft requires the University of Wisconsin School of Medicine and Public Health and the Medical College of Wisconsin to prepare a joint report on how to increase enrollment in the 2 medical schools by persons who resided in health professional shortage areas in Wisconsin at the time they graduated from high school, and on how to develop or expand facilities in health professional shortage areas for training medical doctors or doctors of osteopathic medicine. The report is to be submitted to the governor and the legislature by December 31, 2011.

- 4 (a) The University of Wisconsin School of Medicine and Public Health and the Medical
- 5 College of Wisconsin jointly shall prepare a report on all of the following:

- 7 professional shortage areas in Wisconsin at the time they graduated from high school.
 - 2. How to develop or expand facilities in health professional shortage areas for training
- 9 medical doctors or doctors of osteopathic medicine.
- 10 (b) In this subsection, "health professional shortage area" has the meaning given in
- 11 section 36.60 (1) (aj) of the statutes.

(c) The report under this subsection shall be submitted to the governor and the members
of the legislature in the manner provided in section 13.172 (2) of the statutes no later than
December 31, 2011.
