AN ACT to create 121.91 (4) (p) of the statutes; relating to: an exception to school district revenue limits for expenditures related to the implementation of service consolidation or cooperation, or to the implementation of school district consolidation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

JOINT LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL PREFATORY NOTE: This draft was prepared for the Joint Legislative Council's Special Committee Local Service Consolidation.

Under current law, school districts are subject to revenue limits under s. 121.91, stats. If a school district exceeds its revenue limit, the superintendent of public instruction shall deduct from the state aid payment to the school district an amount equal to the amount by which the district's revenue exceeds its revenue limit.

This bill draft would provide an exception from the revenue limit for the amount that a school district expends, not to exceed 0.1% of the school district's budget, to implement the consolidation, or cooperation for the provision, of one or more services, or to implement the consolidation of school districts.

SECTION 1. 121.91 (4) (p) of the statutes is created to read:

121.91 (4) (p) The limit otherwise applicable to a school district under sub. (2m) in any school year is increased by the amount that a school district expends, not to exceed one—tenth of 1 percent of the school district's budget, to implement the consolidation, or cooperation for the provision, of one or more services, or to implement the consolidation of school districts.
