Save any scholarships student may qualify for in the future. (Could be completed HS2).</p> <p><u>2nd semester</u></p> <p>Education Plan - grades 9 & 10; include grades from transcript and course requests.</p> <p>College Planning Timeline for gr. 9; completed HS1 or HS2.</p> <p>Write/update Career and Life Goals (save previous Career & Life goals and date "new" goals for reference).</p>	<p><u>2nd semester</u></p> <p>Review Career Clusters; students continue to explore career clusters related to careers of interest.
