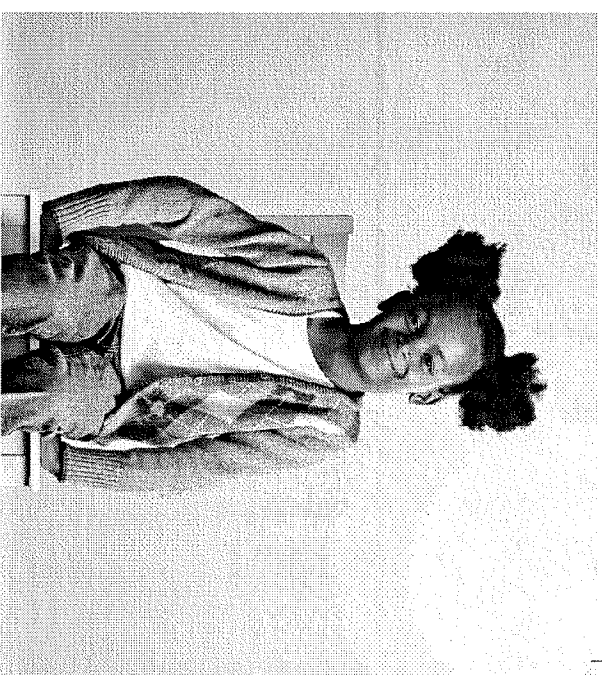
Bethany also provides a full range of post-adoption services and resources, including:

Bethany's ADOPTS program offers a unique, specialized, trauma-focused treatment for adopted children. We help them understand their past traumas so they may thrive in their families. ADOPTS addresses the impact of traumatic experiences on children prior to adoption and gives your child the tools to develop healthier coping skills. Bethany's therapists nurture children and their parents with support, education, and caring intervention.
