JOINT LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL PREFATORY NOTE: This draft was prepared for the Joint Legislative Council's Special Committee on State-Tribal Relations.

Under current law, a school district may contract with another entity to operate a charter school within the district. The process may be commenced by a petition by the teachers of a school or of the district or on the school board's own initiative. If approved, the proposed charter school is established by a contract between the school board and the charter school operator.
