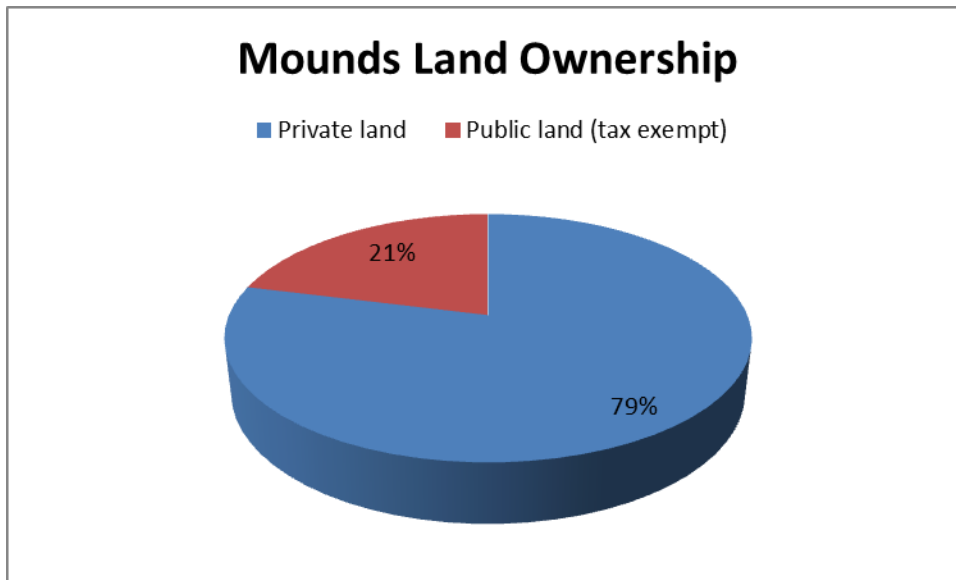

Private: 2183 (79% of Mound Sites)

Public: 583 (21 % of Mound Sites)

*Note: There remain areas of the state that have not disclosed plat records.

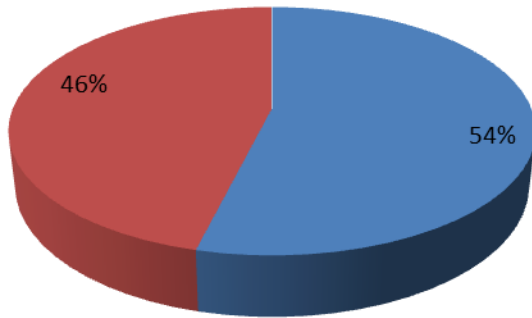
