PRELIMINARY DRAFT - NOT READY FOR INTRODUCTION

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 38.12 (14) of the statutes; **relating to:** minimum enrollment
2 requirements for certain courses offered at technical colleges.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits technical colleges that offer courses as part of a fire fighter or emergency medical services training program from requiring a minimum enrollment in these courses of more than six students.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 38.12 (14) of the statutes is created to read:

4 **38.12 (14) LIMITS ON MINIMUM ENROLLMENT REQUIRED FOR CERTAIN COURSES.** (a)

5 In this subsection:

6 1. "Emergency medical services training program" means a training program
7 for individuals who are, or are undertaking training to become, an emergency

1 medical technician, as defined in s. 256.01 (5), or a first responder, as defined in s.
2 256.01 (9).

3 2. "Fire fighter training program" means a training program for fire fighters
4 under sub. (9) or s. 38.04 (9).

5 (b) Each district board shall establish a written policy for all of its district
6 schools offering a fire fighter training program or emergency medical services
7 training program that prohibits the district school from establishing a minimum
8 course enrollment requirement of more than 6 students for any course offered as part
9 of the program.

10 **SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**

11 (1) This act first applies to courses offered in the first semester or session
12 beginning after the effective date of this subsection.

13 **SECTION 3. Effective date.**

14 (1) This act takes effect on the first day of the 4th month beginning after
15 publication.
