PRELIMINARY DRAFT - NOT READY FOR INTRODUCTION

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 256.15 (10m) of the statutes; **relating to:** allowance of skills
2 redevelopment instructional programs for reinstatement of a license or
3 certificate for certain individuals who previously held a license or certificate as
4 emergency medical services personnel and requiring the exercise of
5 rule-making authority.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

6 **SECTION 1.** 256.15 (10m) of the statutes is created to read:
7 **256.15 (10m)** REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE OR CERTIFICATE IF EXPIRED 2 YEARS OR
8 MORE. (a) The department shall approve skills redevelopment instructional
9 programs for individuals described under par. (c) seeking reinstatement as

1 emergency medical technicians and first responders. The department shall ensure
2 that the instructional programs satisfy standards for approval that are promulgated
3 by rule and meet the following requirements:

4 1. Allow an individual described under par. (c) to receive skills redevelopment
5 instruction.

6 2. Result in the individual under par. (c) having received substantially the
7 same instruction, as determined by the department, as an individual who
8 successfully completes timely renewal of an unexpired license, when combined with
9 the following additional requirements:

10 a. An examination as approved by the department upon completion of the
11 instructional programs.

12 b. Permission from the department for the individual to take the National
13 Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians examination.

14 c. Successful completion of the National Registry of Emergency Medical
15 Technicians examination.

16 (b) The department shall review the curriculum of each approved instructional
17 program at least once every 24 months following the date of approval to determine
18 whether the program continues to satisfy the requirements of this subsection. Under
19 this subsection, the department may, after providing notice, suspend or revoke the
20 approval of an instructional program or impose a plan of correction on the program
21 if the program fails to satisfy the requirements of this subsection or operates under
22 conditions that are other than those contained in the application approved by the
23 department.

24 (c) Only an individual who has held a license or certificate in this state that has
25 been expired for 2 years or more, has not had the license or certificate suspended or
