PRELIMINARY DRAFT - NOT READY FOR INTRODUCTION

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 256.15 (6n); and *to create* 256.20 of the statutes; **relating to:**
2 intravenous technician endorsement for emergency medical technicians.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 256.15 (6n) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 256.15 (6n) AUTHORIZED ACTIONS OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS. An
5 emergency medical technician may undertake only those actions that are authorized
6 under s. 256.20 (3) and in rules promulgated under sub. (13) (c).

7 **SECTION 2.** 256.20 of the statutes is created to read:
8 **256.20 Intravenous technician endorsement. (1) ENDORSEMENT.** The
9 department shall develop an endorsement as an intravenous technician. To be

1 eligible for an endorsement as an intravenous technician under this section, an
2 individual shall meet all of the following criteria:

3 (a) The individual is licensed as an emergency medical technician, that license
4 has not been suspended or revoked, and the individual is not the subject of an action
5 under s. 256.15 (11).

6 (b) The individual successfully completes a training program that has been
7 approved by the department under sub. (2).

8 **(2) TRAINING.** (a) The department shall approve a training program to obtain
9 an intravenous technician endorsement that includes training in successfully
10 administering intravenous and intraosseous infusions of medicated and
11 nonmedicated fluids.

12 (b) The department may approve different training programs for different
13 licensure levels of emergency medical technician.

14 **(3) AUTHORIZED ACTIONS.** An emergency medical technician with an
15 intravenous technician endorsement may undertake those actions described under
16 sub. (2) (a) that are approved by the ambulance service provider or medical director
17 and for which he or she is trained.
