## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, each school board must, as part of the social studies curriculum, include instruction on American Indian history, culture, and tribal sovereignty (American Indian studies) at least twice in the elementary grades and at least once in the high school grades. Under this bill, each private school participating in a parental choice program and each independent charter school must include American Indian studies in the school's curriculum at least twice in the elementary grades and at least once in the high school grades.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**Section 1.** 118.40 (2r) (d) 3. of the statutes is created to read:
