

1 legislature under s. 13.172 (3), a summary report of all reports received by the department
2 under sub. (3) (c) 8. during the previous calendar quarter of abuse, as defined in s. 48.02 (1)
3 (b) to (f), of a child who is was placed in the home of a foster parent or relative other than a
4 parent or in a group home, shelter care facility, or residential care center for children and youth
5 at the time the reported incident of abuse was alleged to have occurred. For each report
6 included in the summary report, the department shall provide the number of incidents of abuse
7 reported; the dates of those incidents; the county in which those incidents occurred; the age
8 or age group of the child who is the subject of the report; the type of placement in which the
9 child was placed at the time of the incident; whether it was determined under sub. (3) (c) 4.
10 that abuse occurred; and, if so, the nature of the relationship between the child and the person
11 who abused the child, but may not provide any of the information specified in sub. (7) (cr) 6.
12 or any information that would jeopardize an investigation, prosecution, or proceeding
13 described in sub. (7) (cr) 7. a. or b.

14 **SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**

15 (1) This act first applies to reports received by the department during the calendar
16 quarter commencing on or after the effective date of this subsection.

NOTE: SECTION 2 clarifies that the bill draft's requirements would apply
to the reports that DCF prepares and transmits starting in the first full
calendar quarter that begins after the bill's effective date.
