PRELIMINARY DRAFT - NOT READY FOR INTRODUCTION

1 **AN ACT to repeal** 302.03 (2); and **to renumber and amend** 302.03 (1) of the
2 statutes; **relating to:** the official oath and bond of wardens and
3 superintendents of the state correctional institutions (suggested as remedial
4 legislation by the Department of Corrections).

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, wardens and superintendents of the state prisons are required to take an official oath and execute a bond. This bill removes the requirement to execute a bond, and expands the requirement to take an official oath to apply to the superintendents of state juvenile correctional facilities as well as wardens and superintendents of state prisons.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

LAW REVISION COMMITTEE PREFATORY NOTE: This bill is a remedial legislation proposal, requested by the Department of Corrections and introduced by the Law Revision Committee under s. 13.83 (1) (c) 4. and 5., stats. After careful consideration of the various provisions of the bill, the Law Revision Committee has determined that this bill makes minor substantive changes in the statutes, and that these changes are desirable as a matter of public policy.
