PRELIMINARY DRAFT - NOT READY FOR INTRODUCTION

1	AN ACT to amend 20.445 (1) (bm) and 106.17 (2) of the statutes; relating to:
2	labor market information system funding and making an appropriation
3	(suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of Workforce
4	Development).

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires the Department of Workforce Development to fund the collection and distribution of local labor forces reports from certain federally funded appropriations. This bill allows DWD to also fund the collection and distribution of local labor forces reports from a sum certain appropriation funded by general purpose revenue.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.445 (1) (bm) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.445 (1) (bm) Workforce training; administration. Biennially, the amounts in the schedule for the administration of the local youth apprenticeship grant

program under s. 106.13 (3m), the local labor market information activities under s.
106.17, the youth summer jobs program under s. 106.18, the employment transit
assistance grant program under s. 106.26, the workforce training program under s.
106.27, the teacher development program grants under s. 106.272, the career and
technical education incentive grant program under s. 106.273, the technical
education equipment grant program under s. 106.275, and the apprentice programs
under subch. I of ch. 106.

Section 2. 106.17 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

106.17 **(2)** The collection and distribution of local labor market information under sub. (1) shall be funded only from the appropriations under s. 20.445 (1) (bm), (m) and (n).

Note: Sections 1. and 2. allow the Department of Workforce Development to use, in addition to the funds available under current law for collecting and distributing local labor forces reports, funds from a sum certain appropriation that is funded by general purpose revenue, for this purpose.
