**PRELIMINARY DRAFT - NOT READY FOR INTRODUCTION**

1     **AN ACT to repeal** 20.445 (5) (kx), 20.445 (5) (kz) and 20.445 (5) (nL); and **to**  
2           **amend** 20.445 (5) (ky) and 20.445 (5) (n) of the statutes; **relating to:**  
3     Department of Workforce Development appropriations, and making an  
4     appropriation (suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of  
5     Workforce Development).

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***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

Under current law, a certain three continuing appropriations provide for the Department of Workforce Development to expend money received by DWD and other state agencies for the administration of certain aids to individuals and organizations, the administration of programs or projects, and for local assistance. This bill combines these expenditure purposes into one continuing appropriation.

Also under current law, a certain federally-funded appropriation provides for DWD to expend funds for local assistance. This bill repeals that appropriation and amends another existing federally-funded appropriation to provide for the expenditure of funds for local assistance.

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***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

1           **SECTION 1.** 20.445 (5) (kx) of the statutes is repealed.

2           **SECTION 2.** 20.445 (5) (ky) of the statutes is amended to read:

3           20.445 (5) (ky) *Interagency and intra-agency aids, programs, or local*  
4 *assistance.* All moneys received from other state agencies and all moneys received  
5 by the department from the department for aids to individuals and organizations, for  
6 the administration of programs or projects for which moneys are received, or for local  
7 assistance.

8           **SECTION 3.** 20.445 (5) (kz) of the statutes is repealed.

NOTE: SECTIONS 1, 2, and 3 combine the provisions of three existing appropriations  
into one appropriation to eliminate unnecessary appropriation alphas.

9           **SECTION 4.** 20.445 (5) (n) of the statutes is amended to read:

10          20.445 (5) (n) *Federal program aids and operations.* All moneys received from  
11 the federal government, as authorized by the governor under s. 16.54, for the state  
12 administration of continuing programs and all federal moneys received for the  
13 purchase of goods and services under ch. 47 and for the purchase of vocational  
14 rehabilitation programs for individuals and organizations, to be expended for the  
15 purposes specified, and for continuing programs to be expended as local assistance  
16 for the purposes specified. From the moneys received by the department under this  
17 paragraph from the social security administration under 42 USC 422 (d) and 1382d  
18 (d), the department shall, in each fiscal year, transfer \$600,000 or the amount  
19 received, whichever is less, to the appropriation account under s. 20.435 (1) (kc).

20          **SECTION 5.** 20.445 (5) (nL) of the statutes is repealed.

NOTE: SECTIONS 4 and 5 combine the provisions of two existing appropriations into  
one appropriation to eliminate an unused appropriation alpha.
