## PRELIMINARY DRAFT - NOT READY FOR INTRODUCTION

AN ACT *to amend* 20.445 (1) (b) and 47.07 (1) of the statutes; **relating to:** use of funds allocated to Project SEARCH and making an appropriation (suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of Workforce Development).

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Workforce Development must allocate in each fiscal year at least \$250,000 from a certain annual appropriation funded by general purpose revenue for the costs associated with contracts entered into under the Project SEARCH program. This bill permits DWD to allocate those funds to costs associated with contracts entered into under the Project SEARCH program, the costs associated with providing vocational rehabilitation services to the program's consumers, and the costs associated with the purchase of goods and services associated with the program.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 20.445 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 5 20.445 (1) (b) Workforce training; programs, grants, services, and contracts.
- 6 The amounts in the schedule for the workforce training programs, grants, and

services under s. 106.27 (1), (1g), (1j), (1r), and (1u) and for the costs associated with
vocational rehabilitation services to consumers, the purchase of goods and services,
and contracts entered into under s. 47.07.

**SECTION 2.** 47.07 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

47.07 (1) The department shall allocate for each fiscal year at least \$250,000 from the appropriation under s. 20.445 (1) (b) for the Project SEARCH program, including vocational rehabilitation services to consumers, the purchase of goods and services, and contracts entered into under this section.

Note: Sections 1 and 2 allow the Department of Workforce Development to use funding that is appropriated for contracted services in administering the Project SEARCH program for noncontracted, vocational rehabilitation services for the program's consumers.
