4	statutes; relating to: procedures and deadlines for the issuance of initial
5	credentials by the Department of Safety and Professional Services and
6	attached credentialing boards.

 occupational licenses, as defined in s. 101.02 (1) (a) 2., in the same manner as those
 statutes apply to credentials, as defined in s. 440.01 (2) (a).

8 SECTION 4. 440.03 (13) (a) 2. of the statutes is renumbered 440.078 (2) (a) 1.,

440.078 (2) (a) 1. (intro.) Once an application is considered complete following
an investigation as provided in subd. 1., the <u>The</u> department shall, for a credential
that is granted by a credentialing board, do one of the following <u>within 31 calendar</u>
<u>days after the date an initial application for the credential is initiated</u>:

14a. Forward the application to the credentialing board or the credentialing 15board's designee with the results of the department's investigation, including the 16 department's determination as to whether the application is complete within the 17meaning of s. 440.03 (13) (a), and a recommendation on whether to approve the 18 application, approve the application with limitations, deny the application, or 19 conduct further review. If the department forwards an application under this subd. 202. 1. a., does not recommend further review of the application, and recommends that 21the application be approved or approved with limitations, the department shall 22notify the credentialing board or credentialing board's designee of the date on which 23the application is forwarded and the date on which the application would be $\mathbf{24}$ considered approved under s. 440.035 (1r) par. (b) unless anything specified in s. 25440.035 (1r) (a) to (d) par. (b) 1. to 4. occurs prior to that date.

1 SECTION 5. 440.03 (13) (e) of the statutes is renumbered 440.078 (2) (a) 2. and 2 amended to read:

3 440.078 (2) (a) 2. After the department submits under par. (a) 2. a. a completed 4 subd. 1. a. an application for a credential to a credentialing board or the designee of 5the credentialing board, for which the department recommends approval or approval 6 with limitations and does not recommend any further review by the credentialing 7 board or the credentialing board's designee, the department may notify the applicant 8 that, unless anything specified in s. 440.035 (1r) (a) to (d) par. (b) 1. to 4. occurs prior 9 to that date, the application will be considered to have been approved by the 10 credentialing board in accordance with the department's recommendation on the 11 10th business day following the date of submission and the credential will be issued 12no later than the 10th business day following that date.

(a) 21 <u>1. a.</u> for which the department recommends approval or approval with limitations 22 and does not recommend further review by the credentialing board or the 23 credentialing board's designee, the application shall be considered to have been 24 approved by the credentialing board in accordance with the department's 1 recommendation on the 10th business day following the date of submission, unless $\mathbf{2}$ one of the following occurs prior to that date:

2. The credentialing board or the credentialing board's designee makes a determination that additional time is required to make a determination on the 4 $\mathbf{5}$ application, not to exceed any deadline established by the department under s. 6 440.03 (1m).

SECTION 8. 440.078 of the statutes is created to read:

8 Initial credentials: procedures and deadlines. The 440.078 (1) 9 department shall, for a credential that is granted by the department, within 45 calendar days after the date an initial application for the credential is initiated, 10 11 make a decision to approve the application, approve the application with limitations, 12or deny the application. If the application is not complete within the meaning of s. 13440.03 (13) (a) at the end of that period, the department shall make a determination 14on the application based upon the information on hand. The department shall notify 15the applicant of the decision.

SECTION 9. 440.078 (2) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

440.078 (2) (c) A credentialing board or a credentialing board's designee shall, 1718 in all cases under par. (b) 2., 3., or 4., make a final decision on an application for an 19 initial credential within 45 calendar days after the application is initiated. If the 20application is not complete within the meaning of s. 440.03 (13) (a) at the end of that 21period, the credentialing board or the credentialing board's designee shall make a 22determination on the application based upon the information on hand.
