





Types of School District Reorganization


- Consolidation
- District Subdivision
- Transfer of Territory/Property Transfer

- Annexation
- Annexation and Transfer

Michigan allows two local boards of education to pass a joint consolidation process, which the state must approve.


State Example

Arizona requires county superintendents to prepare an impact report, detailing how the consolidation will affect the existing districts' operations and includes a consolidation plan.
