GPR-Earned Reestimate (DWD)

CURRENT LAW

Under current law, the Department of Workforce Development (DWD) is estimated to generate \$164,000 GPR-Earned in 2010-11. DWD generates revenue from certain fees and penalties, primarily child labor permit fees.

Under current law, the Department collects a \$10 fee for issuing child labor permits and certificates of age for minors. Of the amount generated by this fee, \$5 is credited to the appropriation for child labor permit system; fees, \$2.50 is credited to the general fund, and \$2.50 is provided as compensation to the local agency that issued the permit or certification.

GOVERNOR

Estimate GPR-Earned from DWD to be \$494,600 in 2011-12 and \$715,200 in 2012-13, for a total of \$1,209,800 for the biennium.

MODIFICATION

Reestimate GPR-Earned from DWD as \$171,900 in 2011-12 and \$173,600 in 2012-13, for a biennial total of \$345,500. As compared to the bill, the reestimates are \$322,700 lower in the first year and \$541,600 lower in the second year, for a total reduction in GPR-Earned of \$864,300.

Explanation: The amounts included in the original bill were calculated incorrectly. This modification reflects the correct calculation.
