Dear Executive Secretary Hutchison:

I am submitting to you a modification request to the 2022-23 Wisconsin Technical College System's (WTCS) Wisconsin Grant formula.

In consultation with the Higher Education Aids Board staff, it has been determined that there is a remaining balance to the WTCS Wisconsin Grant appropriation at the end of the 2022 Fiscal Year. The System is requesting a modification of the approved range for 2022-23 formula by recommending a maximum of \$1,752 and minimum of \$500. The recommendation also includes a second tier award if additional funds are available. In the second tier, the pool of eligible students with an expected family contribution of \$6,626 to \$8,000 would be provided with an award amount of \$500. This will ensure that all enrolled and eligible students receive the financial assistance available which will help alleviate debt and assist students in earning a credential sooner.

I would like to thank you and your staff for providing vital information which assisted in developing this recommendation. We are pleased to offer this recommendation for consideration by the Board.
