SUBJECT: Request for approval of stewardship development grant exceeding \$250,000

Pursuant to s. 23.0917(6m)(a) and (c), Wis. Stats., the Department of Natural Resources is notifying you of a proposed Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program grant in the amount of \$280,632.50 to the City of Prescott for the Magee Park Improvements development project. The Knowles-Nelson Stewardship program is funded under s. 20.866(2)(ta), Wis. Stats.

I. **PROJECT DETAILS:**

Project Sponsor: City of Prescott

Grant Subprogram: Stewardship Local Assistance; Acquisition and Development of Local Parks

Location: Magee Park is located in the City of Prescott, Pierce County.

Project Description: The proposed project will develop a parking lot and accessible asphalt trail at the currently undeveloped Magee Park. The work also includes extending utilities to the park trailhead area and construction of a stormwater pond for runoff from the new parking area. This development will complement the Coulee River Trails System. Allowable trail uses include walking, running/jogging, cross-country skiing, in-line skating and biking. A map and conceptual site plan for this project is attached.

Public Benefit: The proposed park improvements will help to accomplish the City's desire to meet the public need for quality outdoor recreation experiences and facilities that accommodate the abilities of all park users. The trail at Magee Park will provide for future extension opportunities that will expand the offerings of the Coulee River Trails System to the region.

Coordination with recreational planning: This project will advance the purposes of the Stewardship Local Assistance, Acquisition and Development of Local Parks (ADLP) grant program and objectives of local and regional recreation planning efforts. Specifically, the project is supported in the City of Prescott Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (2023-28). Per the purposes of the Stewardship ADLP grant program, the park development will provide a new public nature-based outdoor recreation facility and implement recommendations from the Wisconsin State Trails Network Plan supporting trail connections and developments.

Public Access: Magee Park will be available to the public year-round, 7 days per week, 365 days per year. Users will be able to walk, run/jog, cross-country ski, in-line skate and bike on the trail.

Property Management: The City will be responsible for the operation and maintenance of Magee Park. The project will be designed and constructed to reduce future maintenance costs and the City plans to utilize their park fund to perform long-term maintenance.



Timetable: Construction is scheduled to begin spring of 2024 and is estimated to be completed and fully open to the public by late fall of the same year.


Partnerships: The City has a Memorandum of Understanding with Coulee River Trails (CRT) to assist with trail maintenance and patrol services.
