SUBJECT: Request for approval of stewardship development grant exceeding \$250,000

Pursuant to s. 23.0917(6m)(a) and (c), Wis. Stats., the Department of Natural Resources is notifying you of a proposed Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program grant in the amount of \$305,954.00 to the City of River Falls for the Mann Valley Recreation Trail development project. The Knowles-Nelson Stewardship program is funded under s. 20.866(2)(ta), Wis. Stats.

I. PROJECT DETAILS:

Project Sponsor: City of River Falls

Grant Subprogram: Stewardship Local Assistance; Acquisition and Development of Local Parks

Location: The Mann Valley Recreation Trail will be located in the City of River Falls, St. Croix County.

Project Description: The proposed project will develop a multi-use recreation trail through a newly created Mann Valley Corporate Park. The trail will be paved and include rest areas and lighting. Allowable trail uses include walking, running/jogging, snowshoeing, in-line skating and biking. A map and conceptual site plan for this project is attached.

Public Benefit: The proposed multi-use trail will provide a connection between an existing city park, planned multi-family residential development, conservancy area and Mann Valley Corporate Park. The trail design has taken all ability levels into consideration to provide an inclusive outdoor recreation experience.

Coordination with recreational planning: This project will advance the purposes of the Stewardship Local Assistance, Acquisition and Development of Local Parks (ADLP) grant program and objectives of local and regional recreation planning efforts. Specifically, the project is supported in the City of River Falls Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (2023-28). Per the purposes of the Stewardship ADLP grant program, the trail development will provide a new public nature-based outdoor recreation facility and implement recommendations from the Kinnickinnic River Corridor Plan and the River Falls Bike and Pedestrian Plan supporting trail connections and developments.

Public Access: The Mann Valley Recreation Trail will be available to the public year-round, 7 days per week, 365 days per year. Users will be able to walk, run/jog, snowshoe, in-line skate and bike on the trail, with trail lighting extending the use into the evening hours.

Property Management: The City will be responsible for the operation and maintenance of the trail as part of their regular maintenance schedule. The project will be designed and constructed to reduce future maintenance costs and the City plans to utilize their park fund to perform long-term maintenance.



Timetable: Construction is scheduled to begin mid-summer of 2024 and is estimated to be completed and fully open to the public by the summer of 2025.


